COVID-19 attendance information at our venues 4 Feb 2021

- 1. Services/events currently have a density quotient of 1 person per 2 m^2 . We have a plan for each of our venues.
- 2. Please do not attend if you have **any of the following symptoms**
 - Fever
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Sore throat
 - Runny nose
 - Loss of sense of smell
 - Loss of sense of taste
- 3. Please do not attend if you ...
 - Should be in quarantine
 - Have returned to Australia from overseas in the past 14 days
 - Have had close contact who has a probable, or confirmed case of COVID-19
- 4. We ask you to observe the following:
 - Sit/stand in the places assigned by the event organiser
 - Maintain at least 1.5m distance from others, where possible/practicable
 - Use hand sanitiser
 - Wear a mask indoors unless you are eating or drinking

for food-related functions:

- In Shule, sharing of food is prohibited. After lolly-throws, please leave them on the ground.
- Community facilities are not constrained from sharing food, utensils or items as are places of worship BUT we require you to **use the disinfectan**t provided at the entrance to the hall.

and for religious services:

- NO kissing of the Torah, mezuzah or prayer books
- **If called to the Torah**, follow the instructions given to you at the time including not touching the Torah and keeping 1.5m distance from the Torah reader.
- If asked to **open the ark**, **lift the Torah** (*hagba'ah*) **or wrap the Torah** (*gelilah*), either wear the provided disposable gloves or sanitise your hands before and after.
