**There are no COVID restrictions** relating to food service, Shabbat preregistration or mask wearing in places of worship. Nonetheless, people are encouraged to remain safe and use the hand sanitisers and soaps we have in the Shule and bathrooms.

**SERVICE TIMES:** Our Shabbat morning services commence at 9:00am and typically conclude by 11:30am. **Late arrival of your selected guests may make it impossible for them to receive an honour.**

**DIGNITY & DECORUM:** Please remind your family and friends that mobile telephones and pagers must not be used anywhere on the Shule grounds.

**POST-SERVICE REFRESHMENTS:** If you are interested in serving refreshments after the service, please discuss with Rabbi.

**LOLLIES:** Some families and friends like to shower the groom / Bar Mitzvah boy with lollies after he has been called to the Torah. Kosher lollies can be purchased in many Kosher shops. These need to be delivered to the office by midday on the Thursday prior to your *simchah*. For religious reasons, we do not permit lollies to be brought to the Synagogue on Shabbat.

**HONOURS:** Note that aside from your *simchah*, we may need to accommodate other *semachot* and people commemorating a *yahrzeit*. You may wish to honour male family/friends at your *simchah*. **Please list them on the next page in order of priority should there not be sufficient available honours.**

**OFFERINGS:** Those given an honour are typically invited to make a pledge after receiving the honour. Alternative, you may wish to “buy the *bimah*” and make a donation to cover all pledges that would normally be solicited from the family/friends on the day. In the past, this has been anywhere from \$600 or more.

We encourage hand sanitisation by all people touching shared items such as when reading from the Torah, opening the Ark, holding the Torah, carrying it to the bimah, doing *Hagba'ah* (lifting the Torah) or *Gelilah* (wrapping the Torah). Typically those called to the Torah make a Hebrew blessing (which we also have in English transliteration) prior to and after the call up. Those who open the Ark, do *Hagba'ah*, *Gelilah* or are asked to hold the Torah do not need to say a blessing.
